SCOPE OF THE TRAINING WORKSHOP:

In the framework of **EBSOMED project** - **Enhancing Business Support Organisations** and **Business Networks in the Southern Neighbourhood**, **Union of Mediterranean Confederations of Enterprises** - **BUSINESSMED**, and **Malta Employers' Association** - **MEA**, will organize a Certified Training Course on project development and management targeting Business Support Organisations (BSOs) and aiming at improving their capacity to develop and implement international cooperation projects in the Mediterranean. An emphasis will be dedicated to the ERASMUS + Knowledge Alliances programme.
